

Prince George has been a railway town since its beginnings. This book addresses some of the social issues relevant to the advent of this Grand Trunk Pacific Railway. Two social benefits are seen to accompany railroad freight and passenger services, and enhance lifestyles: a telegraph system and a railway mail service.

Trelle Morrow is a local historian who has spent most of his life in Prince George, where interactions with local pioneers have encouraged his interest. His work has led to research and documentation of sternwheeler operations, aviation development in the north and now a glimpse into our railway heritage.
